CITY COUNCIL DECLARES OCTOBER 9, 2009 AS SCOTT O' LEARY DAY IN THE CITY OF GOLETA

[Goleta, CA] In honor of the memory of long time coach, teacher, and athletic director, Scott O'Leary, who worked at Dos Pueblos High School for 34 years and who touched countless lives with his ethos of hard work, discipline and dedication to student athletics, the Goleta City Council proclaims October 9, 2009 as Scott O' Leary Day in the City of Goleta.

"Scott O'Leary was a great man and great coach. He was a tremendous influence to many generations both on and off the field," said Mayor Roger S. Aceves. It is fitting that the new Dos Pueblos High School Football Stadium is being named after Scott O'Leary.
