#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve the funding recommendations of the Community Project Grant Subcommittee.

#### BACKGROUND:

The FY 2007-08 Budget includes Community Project Grant funding in the amount of \$30,000. The City Council established this appropriation to fund community projects of benefit to the residents of the City of Goleta. Attachment 1 is the Community Project Grant Policy adopted by the City Council on December 3, 2007.

Notice of the availability of this year's Community Project Grant funding was provided via press releases, newspaper ads, the City website, and announcements at public meetings. The deadline for submittal of grant applications was February 11, 2008. Attachment 2 provides a list of the thirty-two applications received, project summaries, and the amount of grant funds requested for each project. Funding requests this year totaled \$77,896.

#### DISCUSSION:

A Community Project Grant Subcommittee, consisting of Mayor Bennett and two mayoral appointees, Julie Caligiuri and Lorelei Moosbrugger, reviewed the FY 2007-08 grant applications. At the outset of the meeting, the committee agreed that their intent was to give projects which focused on children and/or families a priority. The committee members agreed on a shared commitment to the youth of the Goleta community and felt that an investment of grant funds for such purposes represented an investment in the future.

After a thorough review of all applications, the Committee recommended funding twenty-one applications for a total of \$30,000. The specific funding awards recommended for each applicant are specified in Attachment 2. Copies of this year's applications are on file with the Administrative Services Department and available for Council's review.

It should be noted that two of the Community Project Grant applicants also applied for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Service Grant funding. These applicants are as follows:

- 1. Foodbank of Santa Barbara
- 2. United Boys and Girls Club of Santa Barbara County Goleta

However, both the Foodbank and the United Boys and Girls Club have applied for CDBG funding to support other aspects of their operations. The CDBG Council Ad Hoc Committee is aware of the duplicate applicants and has considered those circumstances in their evaluation of the Public Service Grant requests.

Of the projects earmarked for funding, all but one were recommended to receive funding with no stipulations as to their use of grant funds. However, the committee recommended that use of the funding requested for Goleta Valley Beautiful be limited to the replacement of the entryway signs at the Optimist Grove only, and not the funding requested for additional oak tree planting in the grove.

#### FISCAL IMPACTS:

Sufficient funds are available in the FY 2007-08 Budget to support the recommendations of the Community Project Grants Subcommittee.

#### **GOLETA STRATEGIC PLAN:**

The implementation of the 2007/08 Community Project Grant Program is consistent with the Goal in the Goleta Strategic Plan entitled, "Facilitate Delivery of Services to Residents." Specifically, this program meets the Objectives, "Support for Cultural Activities," "Working with and Supporting Local Non Profit Service Agencies" and "Administration of the Community Project Grant Program."

#### CITY OF GOLETA COMMUNITY PROJECT GRANT POLICY FY 2007-08

#### <u>PURPOSE</u>

The City of Goleta has authorized \$30,000 in FY 2007-08 for award of grants to community projects of benefit to the residents of the City of Goleta.

## CATEGORIES OF PROJECTS

Categories of projects eligible for grants include:

- Goleta community organizations
- Cultural activities, e.g. music, art, dance, recreation
- Goleta oriented special events
- Regional projects of benefit to Goletans

## APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications for a grant should include:

- Name and general purpose of the group sponsoring the proposed project
- Name of a contact person for the grant application
- Description of the project in 300 words or less
- Number of people who would be served by the project
- Two references who may be contacted regarding the project
- Individual grants will be limited to no more than \$2,500 in order to benefit a range of activities in the community
- Grant applications will be reviewed by a committee comprised of the Mayor and two City of Goleta residents
- The Mayor will appoint the residents to serve on the committee
- The grant application period will be January 2, 2008 to February 11, 2008.
- The City Council will consider the committee's grant recommendations at the first City Council meeting in April 2008
