Based on Section 17.32.030(A) of the Goleta Municipal Code, the Applicant must conduct an initial site assessment screening to determine the potential presence of hazards that would affect the development proposal. Potential hazards include earthquake hazard zones; areas subject to tsunami run-up; landslides; liquefaction; episodic and long-term shoreline retreat; high seas; ocean waves; storms; tidal scour; flooding; slopes averaging greater than 25%; unstable slopes; and flood hazard areas, including those areas potentially inundated by future sea level rise.
