## GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT AND ORDINANCE AMENDMENT FOR 5631 CALLE REAL CASE NO. 20-0002-GPA, 20-0002-ORD Located at 5631 Calle Real; APNs 069-160-057, -058

**ATTENTION:** Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20 dated March 17, 2020 authorizing local jurisdictions subject to the Brown Act to hold public meetings electronically and telephonically in order to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic, the regular meeting of the (Planning Commission) for September 14, 2020 will be conducted telephonically and electronically. It will be broadcast live on the City's website and on Cable Goleta Channel 19. The Council Chambers will not be open to the public during the meeting. Planning Commissioners will be participating telephonically and will not be physically present in the Council Chambers.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Planning Commission of the City of Goleta will conduct a **public hearing** on the date set forth below to consider the below described project. The public hearing is scheduled as follows:

HEARING DATE/TIME: Monday, September 14, 2020 at 6:00 pm

**Project Description:** Sarah Bronstad of Vanguard Planning Inc., on behalf of The Sun Group LLC, property owner, has requested approval to change the subject property's General Plan land use and zoning designations. The applicant requests a General Plan Amendment to change the General Plan/Coastal Land Use Plan (GP/CLUP) Land Use Element Figure 2-1, the Land Use Plan Map, from Public/Quasi-Public (P-QP) to Community Commercial (C-C). Also requested is an Ordinance Amendment to change the zoning designation from Public/Quasi-Public to Community Commercial (P-QP to C-C), consistent with the proposed General Plan Amendment. No physical development is proposed and no modifications to the existing building are requested. The site is located in the Inland area.

The request is also to adopt a Notice of Exemption pursuant to 14 California Code of Regulations § 15090. The Planning Commission's action is advisory to the City Council. The City Council is the City decisionmaker for the project.

**ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW FINDINGS:** Pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code, §§ 21000 et seq.), the regulations promulgated thereunder (14 Cal. Code of Regulations, §§ 15000, et seq.), and the City's Environmental Review Guidelines, the project has been found to be exempt from CEQA and a Notice of Exemption is proposed. The City of Goleta is acting as the Lead Agency for this project.

Specifically, the project is categorically exempt from environmental review pursuant to the following CEQA Guidelines:

- No possibility of significant effect [Section 15061(b)(3)]
- The activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment [Section 15060(c)(2)]

**CORTESE LIST:** Further, the site is not listed on any hazardous waste facilities or disposal sites as enumerated under Section 65962.5 of the California Government Code (the "Cortese list").

**REVIEW PROCESS:** On March 3, 2020, the City Council agreed to initiate the General Plan Amendment for further study and the applicant submitted the necessary applications leading to this public hearing. The next step in the review process is a Planning Commission hearing, which is the subject of this notice, with a

recommendation to the City Council of the merits of the project. Lastly, City Council consideration of the request at a noticed public hearing and rendering of a decision on the merits of the project.
