ARGUMENT AGAINST MEASURE B2022

The one percent sales tax increase proposed by Measure B2022 comes at a time when Inflation is at its highest level in four decades. Interest rates are at their highest in over twenty years, leading to an increased burden on credit rates, auto loans, and mortgage rates, which are at their highest level since the 2008 recession. California's gas tax increased by three cents a gallon in July. And we are likely headed toward a recession. There could not be a worse time to increase taxes.

Measure B2022's tax increase does not have an expiration date and will not require a future renewal vote. Instead, it would be a permanent tax that could only be repealed by a future ballot initiative, which is unlikely. Since this is a general tax measure with no oversight committee, there is no legal requirement that any of the money generated by this tax be used for the purposes listed by the proponents. The revenue could be spent however current and future city councils decide.

Sales taxes are regressive, meaning that they take a larger percentage of income from low-income taxpayers than high-income taxpayers. Increased sales taxes also make it more difficult for local small businesses to compete. This sales tax increase will place an unnecessary burden on all Goleta taxpayers, while disproportionately affecting Goleta's more vulnerable residents and small businesses.

In the near future Goleta taxpayers will likely have to find ways to reduce expenditures to provide for themselves and their families. It is only fair that the City do the same, rather than implementing a sales tax increase when it will impact taxpayers the most. Vote NO on Measure B2022.
