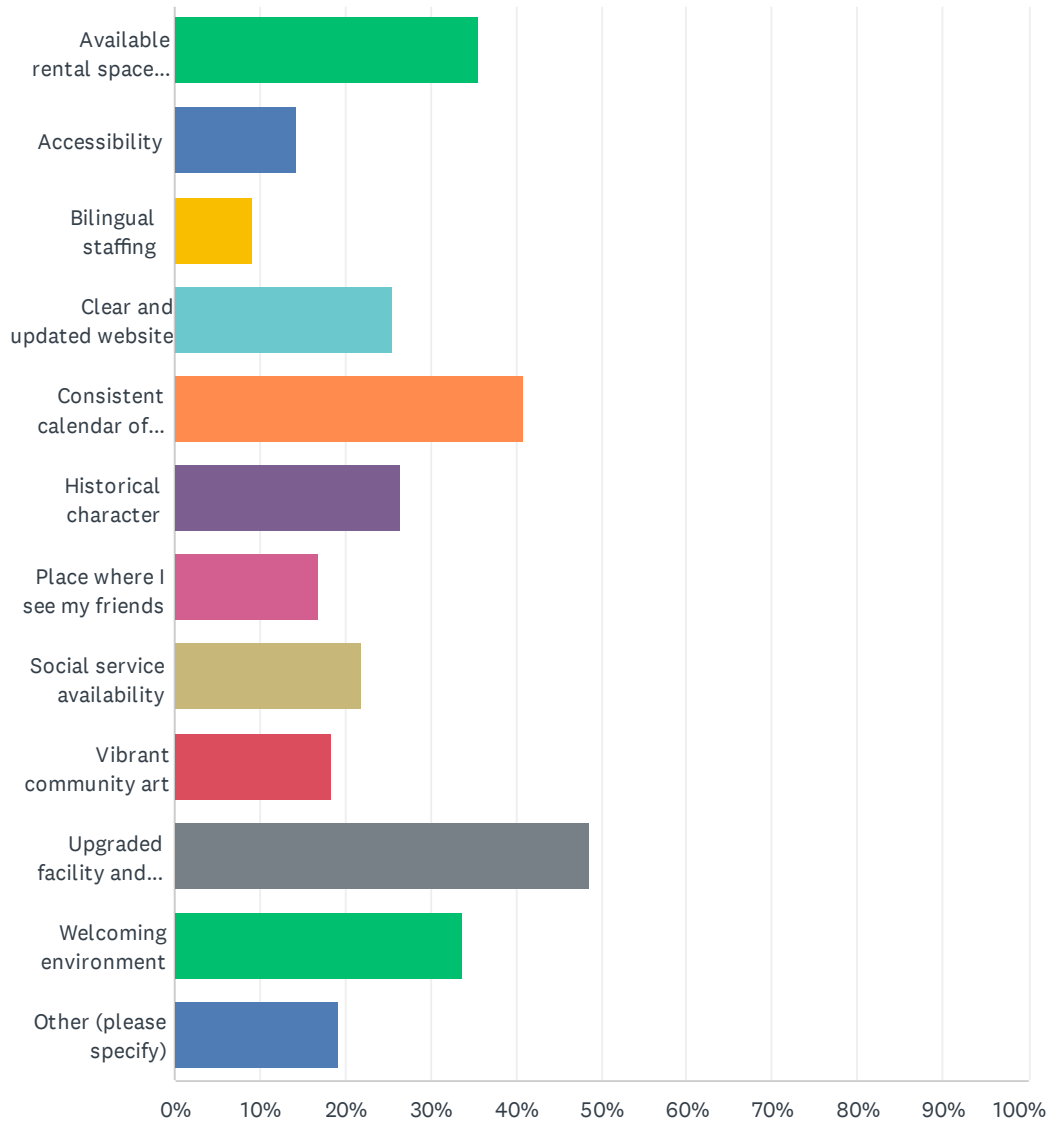


Q1 What is most important to your future experience at the Goleta Community Center? (select up to 3)

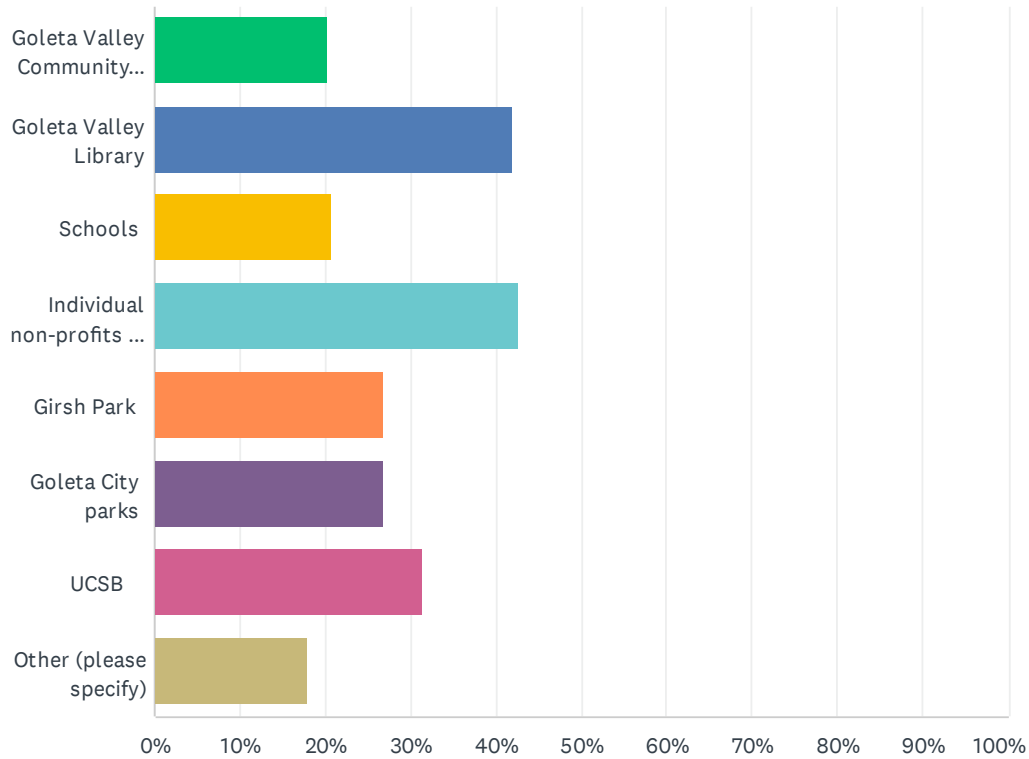

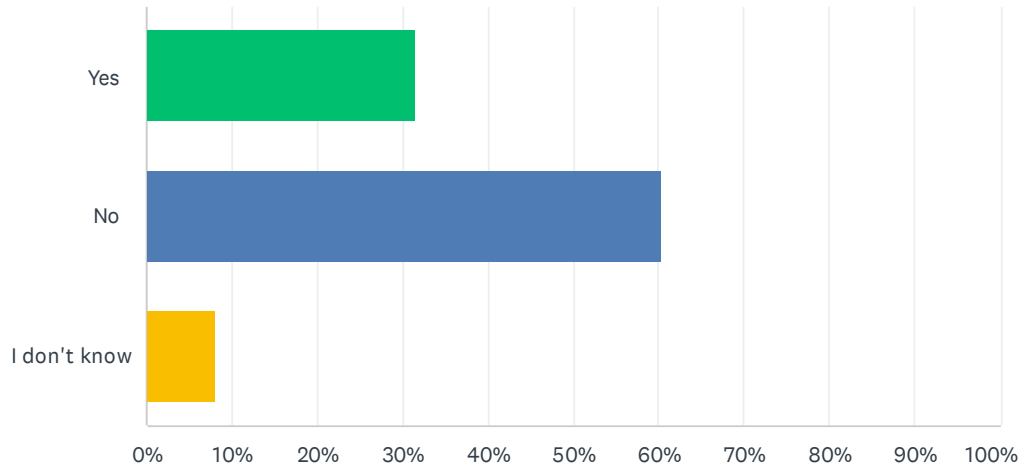

Q12 If you selected District 2 above, do you live in Old Town?

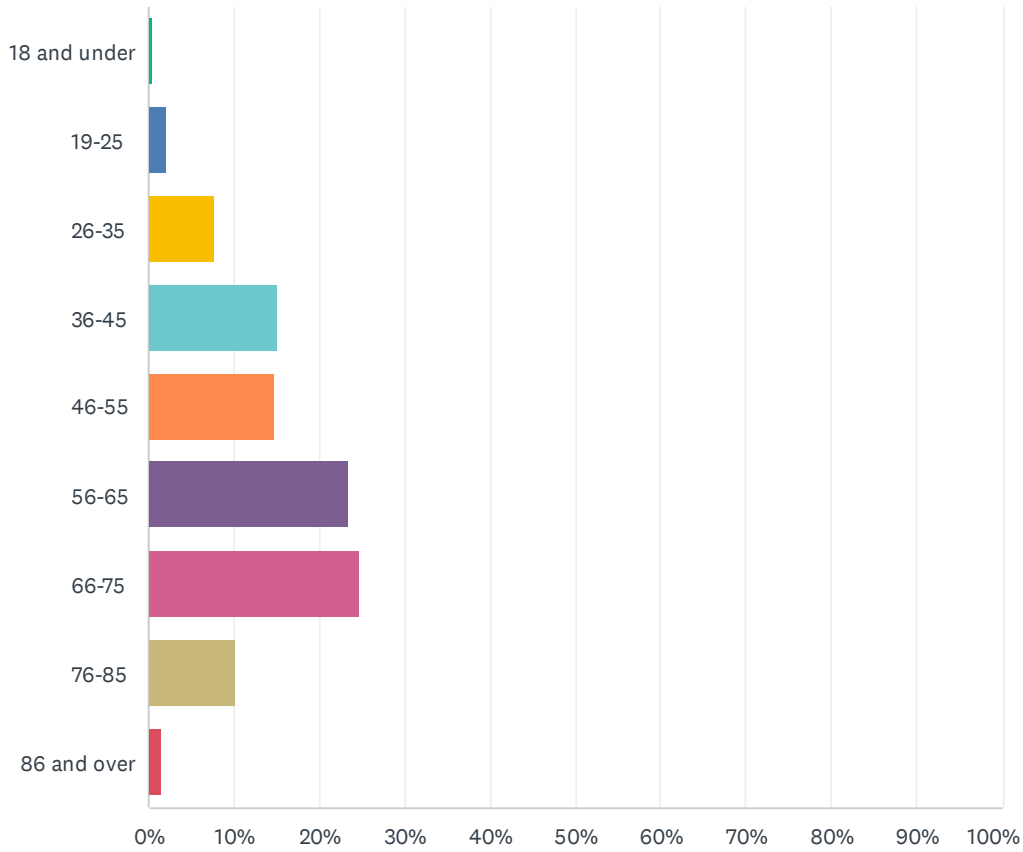

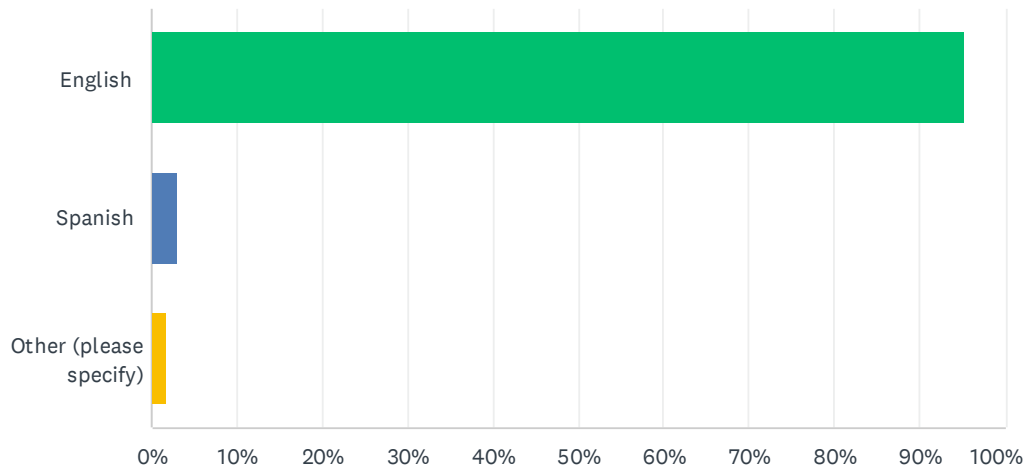

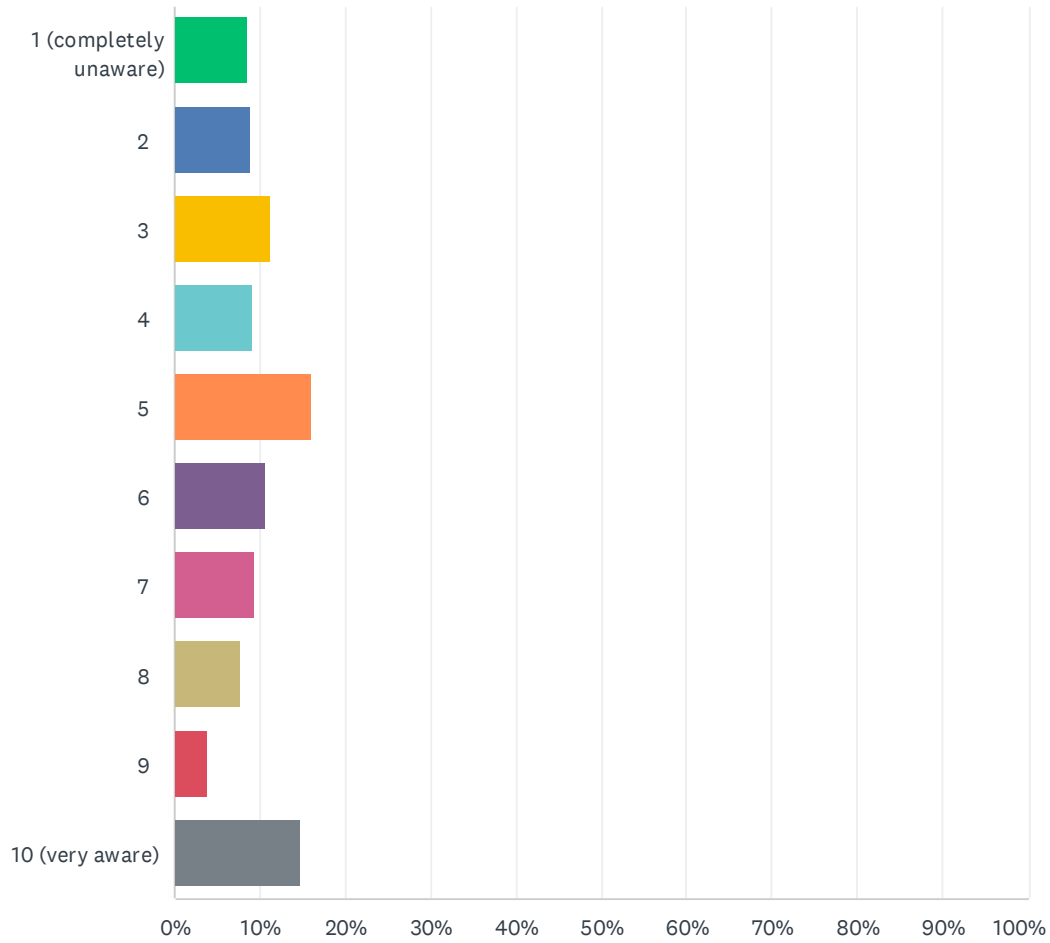
