I live at 7368 Hollister Avenue. I live in a mobile Home Park there. The City of Goleta is planning two housing projects next to our park. The first at 35 Ellwood Station Road is on a defunct Vulcan Cement Plant. It operated a few years ago. This plant is a hazardous waste site. It is also directly across a road from our park. The City plans a 146 unit residential housing unit . A large housing unit on a hazardous waste site. This site is on a small cul de sac with our 75 space mobile home park, and a large condominium complex. The developer took down about 20 Eucalptus Trees and two large cement silos with no permits .

The other housing unit is right next to our park on the other side. It is a privateresidence that the City wants to turn into 70 housing units. This would mean 300 housing units in a couple of acres of space.

The City does not believe in EIR's and these projects would make our access road a nightmare not to mention the main road. This road is already a nightmare.

So we are talking about 300 housing units in less than one square acre of land.

I am opposed to developing a hazardous waste plant into housing and dropping another 70 homes literally in our driveway.
