CITY ATTORNEY'S IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF MEASURE "G2024" EXTENDING MEASURE "G2012" BY TWENTY ADDITIONAL YEARS

Measure "G2012" requires that, until December 31, 2032, a majority of the voters of the City of Goleta must vote to approve a decision to re-designate or change the intensity of use on parcels within the City of Goleta that are designated "Agriculture" and that are ten (10) or more acres in size. The proposed Measure "G2024" would extend the date that Measure G2012 terminates by twenty years from December 31, 2032 to December 31, 2052.

A "yes" vote on Measure G2024 would, effective December 31, 2032, extend the date that Measure G2012 terminates by twenty additional years until December 31, 2052. This means that for twenty additional years beyond the current termination date, a majority of Goleta voters would be required to approve any decision to re-designate or change the intensity of use on parcels designated "Agriculture" and that are ten or more acres in size.

A "no" vote on Measure G2024 would allow Measure G2012 to terminate on December 31, 2032. This means that agricultural parcels of land that are ten or more acres in size could be re-designated or changed as to intensity of use without requiring a vote of the people of Goleta following that termination date.
