Dear Scott:

The following is our August Progress Report for the Fairview Gardens CUP.

Fundraising efforts were recently curtailed; however, with the recent installation of Fairview Gardens' new Executive Director, Jenny Millan, fundraising work has resumed. Jenny is actively working on grant development and a draft for a six month business plan scheduled for board and staff work October, '09.

Post construction clean up continues, some with the help of our neighbors.

The final draft of the Irrevocable Offer to Dedicate, written by Philip Seymour, Esq. and signed by the Fairview Gardens Vice President and President of the board with notarization, has been delivered to the City of Goleta.

Plans for the refuse enclosure are being revised. It remains the intention of Fairview Gardens to have the trash enclosure relocated as soon as possible despite the fact that this is not a requirement until completion of Phase 5 in 2013.

Phase 5 is the only phase that remains to be completed. A detailed progress report for Phase 5 and fundraising follows:

# Phase 5

Architect Dennis Thompson created a design concept for the Phase 5 permanent housing project. This was submitted to DRB on January 27, 2009 and received Conceptual Review. The project is off the DRB's calendar for the next one to two years, until such time that the Fairview Gardens has raised enough funds to move Phase 5 forward within a reasonable timeline.
