#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

A. Conduct a workshop to review and revise the City's Strategic Plan.

B. Prioritize objectives in the Strategic Plan.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The City's Strategic Plan is updated on a periodic basis to keep it relevant with the City's current priorities and projects. This workshop will be the first time the newly appointed Council has reviewed the Strategic Plan since the November 2010 elections. The goal of the special workshop is to allow Council an opportunity to review the Vision Statement, the Goals and Objectives in the Strategic Plan, and allow Council and staff to add any new objectives to the Plan. At the end of the workshop, Council will have time to choose their priorities amongst the objectives.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

#### **Workshop Format**

The workshop will begin with an overview of the expectations and goals of the workshop. A detailed Agenda is included as Attachment 1 to this report. Staff will provide a short overview of the agenda for the workshop. Council will begin with a review of the Vision Statement (Attachment 2) and the thirteen Goals (Attachment 3). These can be affirmed or edited during Council review. Council and staff will then review the current Strategic Plan (Attachment 4), which includes recommended edits, revisions and deletions proposed by staff. This draft Plan includes additional columns to help Council understand the timeline of each objective, an approximate budget amount (where applicable) and if the objective is included in the next 2-year budget cycle. The column "Council Priority" will be used to eventually indicate the Council's selected priorities.

The Plan includes color coded areas indicating where revisions have been made. These areas highlight where Staff is requesting Council review and provide further direction during the workshop. An explanation of the coding used in the Plan is provided below:
