RE: Preliminary Conditions Letter for Willow Springs II

Dear Gary:

Thank you for your email regarding the water usage on Willow Springs and your estimate of water use for Willow Springs Phase II. We have done an analysis of actual water use at Willow Springs because we believe there is much in common with the two projects.

We agree that the average use at Willow Springs has been 39.23 AFY, but of that amount, 12.24 AFY was the average annual use for the eight landscape meters, so the domestic use for the 235 units was 25.99 AFY (.115 AFY per unit for the 235 units). There is 6.05 acres of landscaping in Willow Springs, because it was developed at a considerably lower density than Willow Springs Phase II, so the actual water use for Willow Springs irrigation was 2.02 AFY per acre of landscaping.

Applying those factors to Willow Springs Phase II, we believe that a reasonable estimate for the 100 units would be 11.50 AFY, and for the 1.41 acres of landscaping, it would be 2.85 AFY, for a total of 14.35 AFY.

If anything, the amount of water use per apartment unit in Willow Springs Phase II will be less than Willow Springs because we have 48% one bedroom units in Willow Springs Phase II (48 out of 100 units), while we have only 13.6% one bedroom units in Willow Springs (32 out of 235 units). In any event, we believe these numbers speak for themselves.

We have some other concerns with the Preliminary Conditions Letter, including but not limited to the use of recycled water, but we will do further analysis of the situation before providing our feedback on it. However, it would be helpful to know if we are in agreement on the estimated water usage for Willow Springs Phase II, so we request that you review our figures and confirm their accuracy.



### For obtaining a Can & Will Serve Letter:

- . 1. Water service for the proposed project is NOT subject to the District Water Allocation procedures. No action is required on your part.
  - 2. There is no New Water Supply Charge for this project. See Attachment A for details.
  - 3. Submit payment of the New Meter Installation fee in the amount of \$42,818.00. See Attachment B for details.
