A.1 Construction Contract for the FY 2008-2009 Pavement Rehabilitation Project, Phase 2 – Slurry Seal (Wagner)

- A. Authorize the City Manager to execute a construction contract for Phase 2 of the FY 2008-2009 Pavement Rehabilitation Project, Slurry Seal to Bond Blacktop, Inc., in the amount of \$923,125 subject to the requirements of the contract documents; and
- B. Authorize the City Manager to approve contract change orders as necessary for Phase 2 of the FY 2008-2009 Pavement Rehabilitation Project, Slurry Seal in an amount not to exceed \$180,000.

C. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEM

C.1 Correspondence regarding the Goleta Fireworks Festival at Girsh Park and response to U.S. Department of Fish & Wildlife (Adomaitis) (15 minutes)

<u>Recommendation</u>: Authorize the Mayor to forward correspondence to Congresswoman Lois Capps regarding the U.S. Department of the Interior Fish and Wildlife Service's (USFWS) May 19, 2008 correspondence regarding the Goleta Fireworks Festival at Girsh Park.

C.2 Resolution Approving a Council-Sponsored Ordinance to Be Submitted to the Voters Entitled, "A Council-Sponsored Ordinance of the City of Goleta Adding a New Chapter 3.19 to the Goleta Municipal Code Relating to the Imposition of an Additional One-Half of One-Percent (.50%) Sales and Use Tax within the City of Goleta to Be Effective for a Period of 30 Years.

(Biggs) (30 minutes)

Recommendation:

- A. Adopt a resolution approving one of the following sales and use tax ordinances to be submitted to the voters for the establishment of an additional City sales and use tax, and direct the City Attorney to prepare an Impartial Analysis as required by law:
 - 1. A Sales and Use Tax Ordinance Establishing a One-Half Cent (.50%) Sales and Use Tax for a Period of Thirty Years; or
 - 2. A Sales and Use Tax Ordinance Establishing a One-Half Cent (.50%) Sales and Use Tax for a Period of Thirty Years to Commence Upon the Expiration and Termination of County Adopted Measure D; or
 - 3. A Sales and Use Tax Ordinance Establishing a One-Half Cent (.50%) Sales and Use Tax for a Period of Thirty Years to Take Effect only if Measure A Fails to Pass in the November 4, 2008 Election; or
 - 4. A Sales and Use Tax Ordinance Establishing a One-Half Cent (.50%) Sales and Use Tax for a Period Of Thirty Years To Take Effect Only If Measure A Fails To Pass in the November 4, 2008 Election Upon the Expiration and Termination of Measure D; or
 - 5. A Sales and Use Tax Ordinance Establishing a One-Quarter (.25%) Cent Sales and Use Tax for a Period of Thirty Years.
- C.3 Resolution Approving a Council-Sponsored Ordinance Repealing the Revenue Neutrality Agreement to Be Submitted to the Voters.
 (Biggs) (30 minutes)

Recommendation: Adopt resolution No. 08-__ entitled "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Goleta, California, Approving an Ordinance of the City of Goleta Amending and Repealing Certain Provisions of Section 17 of Measure H2001 and Amending and Repealing Related Provisions of the Revenue Neutrality Agreement Ratified by the Goleta City Council to Implement Measure H2001 on February 1, 2002 Relating to Revenue Neutrality Payments from the City to the County of Santa Barbara" thereby approving the Council-sponsored initiative measure for submission to the electorate.

C.4 Resolution Calling and Giving Notice of the Holding of a General Municipal Election to be held in the City on November 4, 2008 for the Election of Certain Officers, and Two Proposed Council-Sponsored Measures.

(Constantino) (10 minutes)

Recommendation:

Adopt resolution No. 08-__ entitled: "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Goleta, California, Calling and Giving Notice of the Holding of a General Municipal Election to be Held in the City on Tuesday, November 4, 2008, for the Election of Certain Officers as Required by the Provisions of the Laws of the State of California Relating to General Law Cities and Council-Sponsored Initiative Ordinances submitted to the Electorate."

C.5 Resolution Requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara to Consolidate a General Municipal Election to Be Held on November 4, 2008 (Constantino) (10 minutes)

Recommendation:

Adopt Resolution No. 08-__ entitled "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Goleta, California, Requesting that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara Consolidate a General Municipal Election for the Purpose of Electing Two Members of the City Council and Submission of Two Council-Sponsored Ordinances to the Voters to Be Held on November 4, 2008, with the Statewide General Election to Be Held on the Date Pursuant to Section 10403 of the Elections Code."

C.6 Resolution Relating to Council-Sponsored Ballot Measures, Establishing Procedures for Submitting Ballot Arguments and Rebuttal Arguments for City Measures Submitted at Municipal Elections.

(Constantino) (10 minutes)

Recommendation:

In accord with California law, approve resolutions as follows:

- Determine whether the City Council or any individual member(s) of City Council will file an argument regarding the proposed ordinance, and if so, adopt Resolution No.08-__ entitled "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Goleta, California, Authorizing and Setting Priorities for Filing of a Written Argument Regarding the Ordinances to be Placed on the Ballot for the November 4, 2008 General Election; and
- 2. Determine if rebuttal arguments will be permitted regarding the proposed ordinance, and if so adopt Resolution No. 08-__ entitled "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Goleta, California Providing for the Filing of Rebuttal Arguments for City Measures Submitted at Municipal Elections.
